Let us sit and bask in them. Let us slow down and feast on them. Many of them come from the Gospel of Luke and the story of Christ's coming to earth to be our Savior. The passage from Genesis is that beautiful reminder of God's covenant with Abraham and with us His people which came to complete fulfillment in the person and work of Jesus on the cross and by His resurrection from the dead. There is a very well known passage from the Gospel of John that we may need to especially slow down and read as if hearing it for the first time. The last passage is the place in scripture where Paul interweaves these three eternal gifts together and reminds us that they are yours and ours not just today, but for eternity.

Wow! What a month. Two months, actually. You may have noticed that we did not send an email update in October. We have had very wonderful highs and very difficult lows over the last two months. We appreciate your prayers-both requests and thanksgivings. We have felt very supported, even in the midst of both chaos and total joy.

Due to enlarged tonsils and repeated tonsillitis, our doctor recommended that MaryJane get her tonsils removed. Unfortunately, this surgery cannot happen in Maun, where we live, so on October 30, Carl and MJ flew down to Gaborone, Botswana's capital, for the surgery on October 31. She had a long recovery but is feeling much better now.

While Carl and MJ were away, Judah came down with a stomachache. By the end of the day, it was clear that it was no ordinary stomachache. Kelsey took him to the hospital in town and he had an emergency appendectomy that night. It was a very rough week, but we are so thankful for our friends who cared for our family so well during this time.

Just after all our medical trauma, we were honored to be a part of the Wayeyi launch of the book of Matthew. It was a huge community event, bringing lots of recognition to the project and to God's word in all languages. Join us in thanking God for this event and for the Matthew booklet to be distributed and used far and wide. We were able to launch the audio recording and smartphone app of the book at the same time. Praise God!

About a week after the Matthew launch, our family left for the US for a short home assignment. We are visiting a few churches while we are back (just for 6 weeks) and spending time with our families. We are so grateful for this time to recharge and connect with many of you. See below for our schedule of church visits! On our way back to the US, we were able to extend our layover for a couple of days and experience Paris together as a family. We all loved the croissants and macarons, plus the museums and monuments. We made memories that will last a lifetime!
