A Word from the Pastor, continued

Lastly, I have some VERY exciting news for you. Our spanish-speaking congregation Elevate continues to connect with new people in our community and is growing as they worship at 1pm on Sunday's here at TOL. They have also launched a new satellite ministry at an assisted living center the last few months that continues to grow. Jaime & Sonia Durkin have also taken a major step and have been accepted as seminary students through Concordia Seminary in St. Louis through the Hispanic Ministry Institute. We are going to have a special commissioning service for Jaime & Sonia on Sunday, October 15th at 10:30am. This will be a joint worship gathering with the families of Elevate as well. Jaime will be commissioned as a vicar and Sonia as a deaconess in training. The Texas District has stepped up to pay for their seminary studies and we couldn't be more excited for this new chapter in their ministry here at TOL in reaching our Spanish-speaking neighbors! Please plan to join us for worship & a potluck lunch together on October 15th!

This all reminds me as well of 2 of our other core biblical values that we will dive deep into this month through our series "We Are Tree". These values are "Welcoming To All People" and "Enthusiastically Growing God's Kingdom". Remember Christ's parting words of commissioning to his disciples and to us as His church in Matthew 28:18-20, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

So also we have this powerful prayer that Jesus prayed in Matthew 9:36-38. It says, "When he (Jesus) saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; *therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.*"

How awesome that the Lord has again answered this prayer by placing among us a loving, godly couple in the Durkin's to go out into the harvest field to share the Gospel in their native tongue. Our God is awesome, isn't He?!

One last bible passage comes to mind when it comes to these biblical core values and what the Lord is doing among us. Meditate on this one with me. It is in 1 Corinthians 9:22-23, "I have become all things to all people, that by all means I might save some. I do it all for the sake of the gospel, that I may share with them in its blessings." How can you and I "be Christ" in tangible, loving, and purposeful ways to our neighbor today and each day?

Let us pray. Holy Spirit, lead us and guide us to share your Good News as we are rooted in your Word so that more and more may come to know You and Your salvation, all to the glory of Jesus. Amen!


